VETERINARY REPORT

Horse presented for soundness check-up prior to Nutrien Classic Sale on 22/01/25 with history of laceration to the plantar aspect of the RH Metatarsus (cannon) sustained in October 2024. Colt was sound at the walk and trot with no pain or sensitivity noted on palpation of the RH flexor tendons. Ultrasound of this region confirmed this wound did not involve the flexor tendons or digital sheath. Scar tissue visible at the site of the lesion does not extend deeper to the Superficial Digital Flexor Tendon and no radiographic abnormalities noted in the RH Fetlock or cannon/splint bones. Some permanent scarring at the site of injury is expected however this is not considered a significant risk to future soundness.
